The latest news as of 5.45pm on Sunday 14 February

17 deaths and 788 cases confirmed:

- the Health Protection Surveillance Centre (HPSC) has been informed of 17 additional deaths among people with COVID-19 in Ireland. 15 of these deaths occurred in February, 1 in December and 1 is still being investigated
- there have been 3,948 COVID-19 related deaths in Ireland
- 7,88 additional cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed
- there have now been 209,582 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Ireland
- as of 8am today (Sunday), 899 COVID-19 patients are hospitalised, of which 160 are in ICU. There have been 34 additional hospitalisations in the past 24 hours

As of Thursday 11 February, there have been 261,073 doses of COVID-19 vaccine administered in Ireland:

- 171,239 people have received their first dose
- 89,834 people have received their second dose
