HOW DO I PROTECT MYSELF AND

Wash your hands as often as possible

1. Eat

3. After using the restroom
4. Sneeze, cough, blow or wipe your nose
5. Touch animals or pets



What are the steps of handwashing?



Wet hands  
with water.



Apply enough soap to cover  
all areas of your hands.



For 20 seconds, scrub the middle and back of both  
hands, wrists, between fingers and under fingernails.



Rinse hands  
properly.



Dry hands with  
a paper towel.

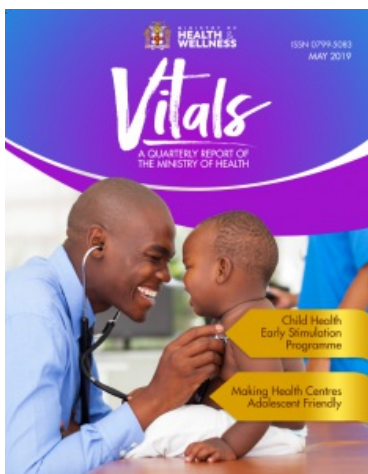

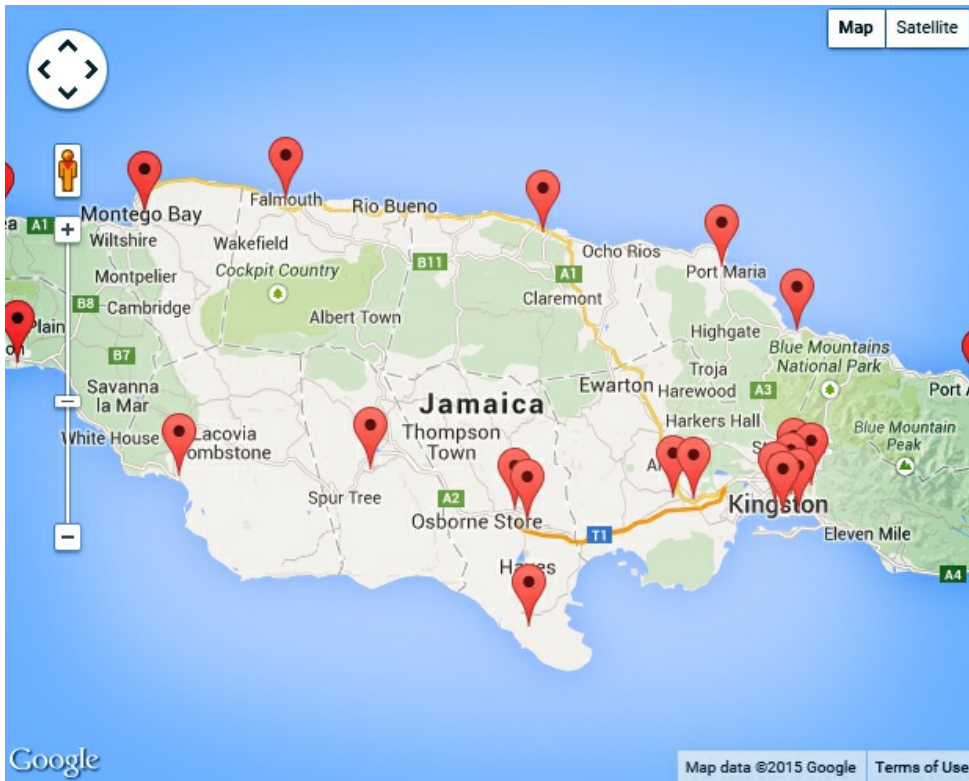

# PINK EYE AND YOU

Conjunctivitis other-wise known as "Pink Eye", is an infection of the eyes. It is caused mainly by a virus which enters the eyes by contaminated:

- HANDS
- WASH RAGS
- COSMETICS
- HANDKERCHIEFS
- CONTACT LENS
- OTHER PERSONAL ITEMS

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS	PREVENTION
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Redness of the eyes</li> <li>Itchy or burning eyes</li> <li>Grainy feeling in eyes</li> <li>Sensitivity to light</li> <li>Watery eyes</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do not share make up, eye drops, wash rags etc.</li> <li>Avoid shaking hands with infected persons</li> <li>WASH HANDS OFTEN when coming in contact with persons with pink eye</li> </ul>

**TREATMENT & CARE:**

- Pour boiled water that has been cooled on to clean tissue/cotton and wipe eyes of least 3 times for the day
- Throw tissue/cotton in garbage after each use
- Avoid rubbing eyes
- Do not attend school/work/other crowded places until infection clears
