Dry hands with  
a paper towel.

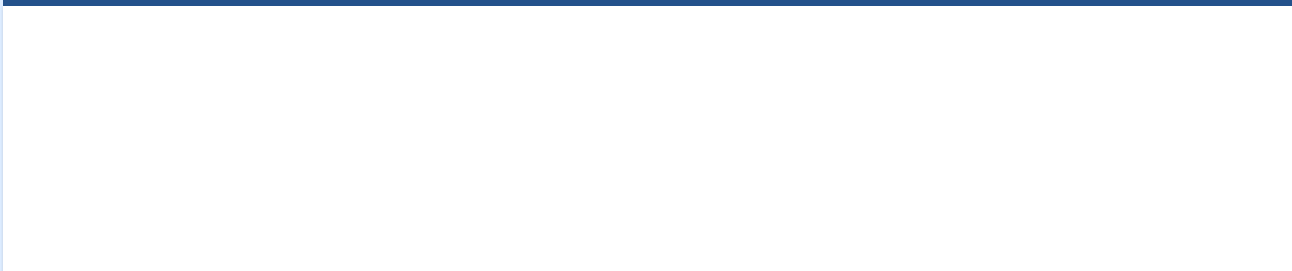
