

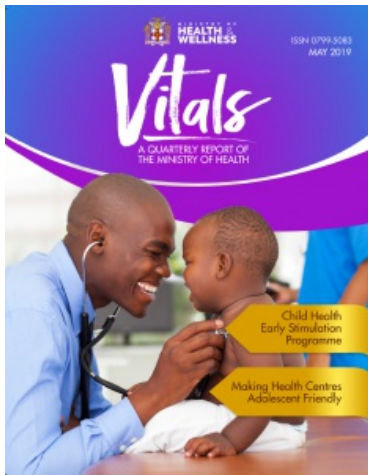

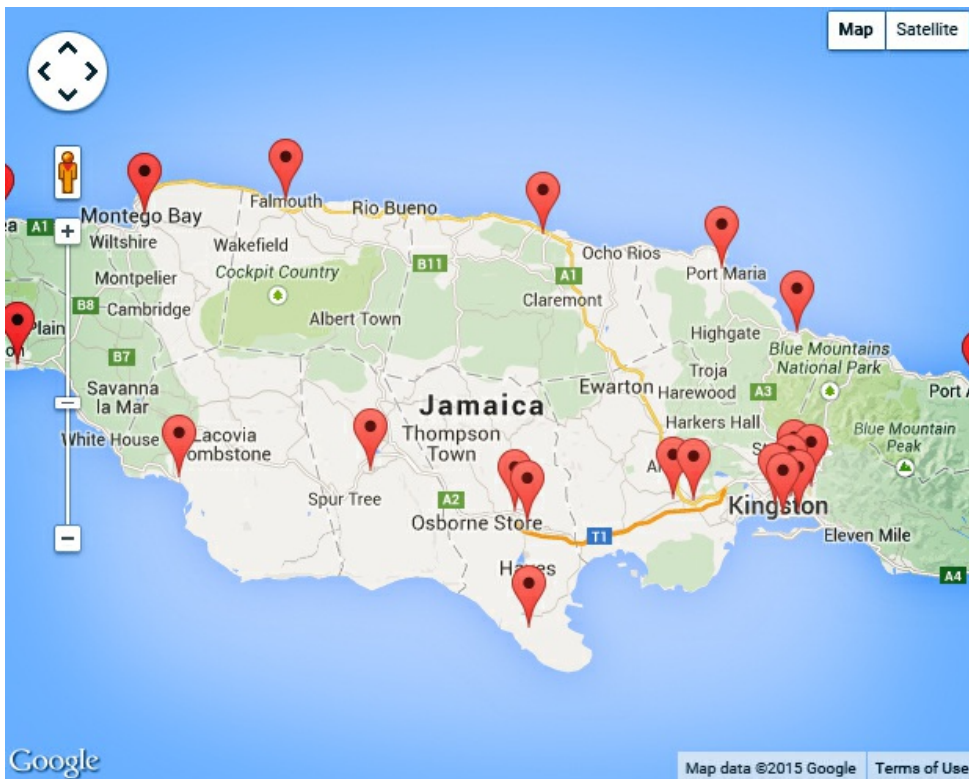

**PINK EYE AND YOU**

Conjunctivitis other-wise known as "Pink Eye", is an infection of the eyes. It is caused mainly by a virus which enters the eyes by contaminated:

- o HANDS
- o WASH RAGS
- o COSMETICS
- o HANDKERCHIEFS
- o CONTACT LENS
- o OTHER PERSONAL ITEMS

**SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS**

Redness of the eyes  
Itchy or burning eyes  
Grainy feeling in eyes  
Sensitivity to light  
Watery eyes



**PREVENTION**

Do not share make up eye drops, wash rags etc.  
Avoid shaking hands with infected persons.  
**WASH HANDS OFTEN** after coming in contact with pink eye.

**TREATMENT & CARE:**

- Pour boiled water that has been cooled on to clean tissue/cotton and wipe eyes at least 3 times for the day.
- Throw tissue/cotton in garbage after each use.
- Avoid rubbing eyes.
- Do not attend school/work/other crowded places until infection clears.
