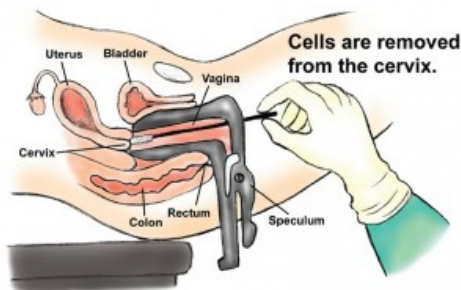
LOCATION OF HOSPITALS AND HEALTH CENTRES
