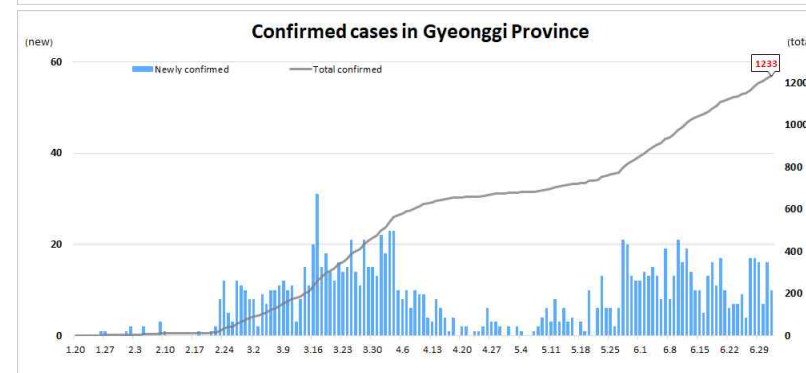

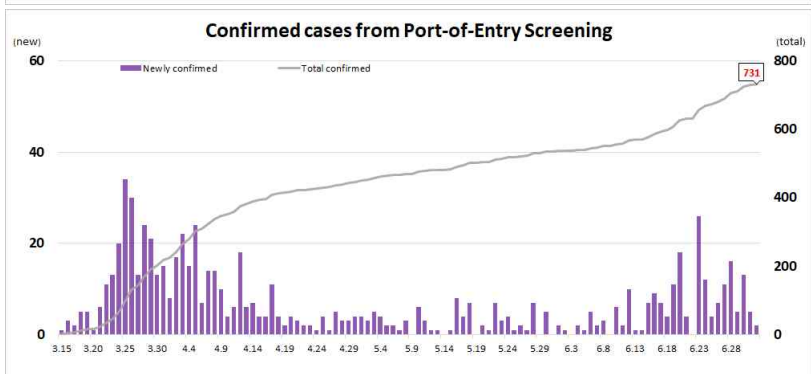
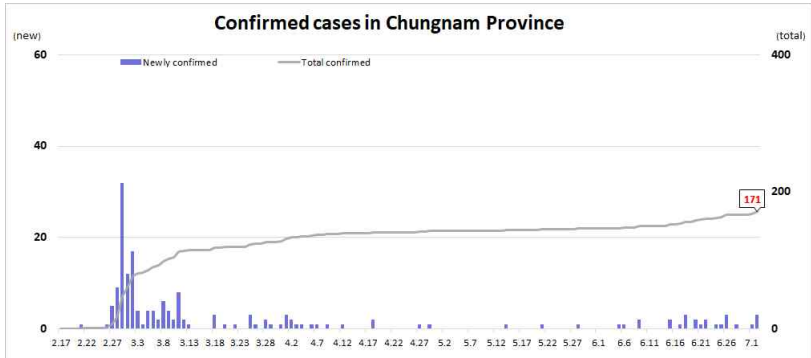
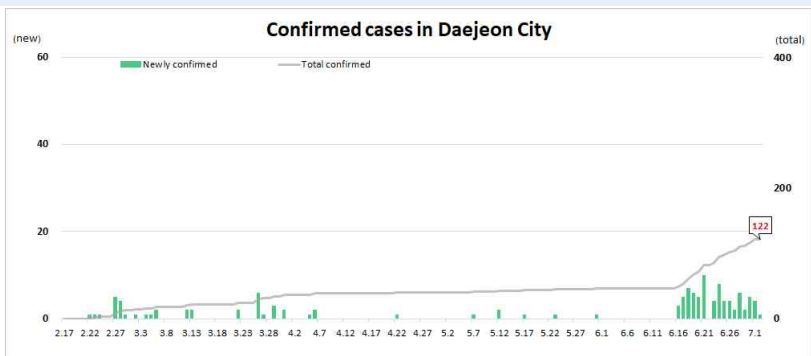


DAILY NEW AND TOTAL CASES IN SEOUL/INCHEON/GYEONGGI REGIONS

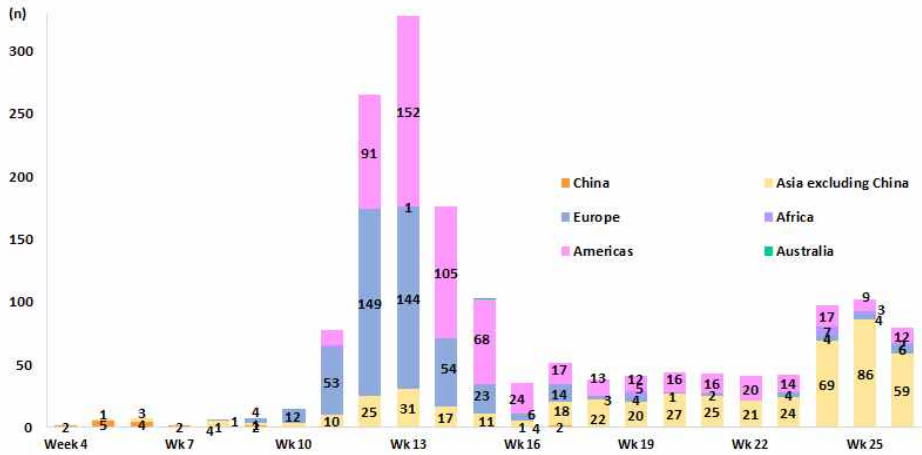
