Current situation COVID-19: New infections, hospitalisations in intensive care, deaths

People tested **positive** for COVID-19: **3.444**

- › Residents: **2.830**
- › Non-residents: **614**
- › Average age: **46 years**
- › Ratio men / women: **50,6% / 49,4%**

Tests **carried out** since the beginning of the crisis: **31.660**

- › Residents: **25.797**
- › Non-residents: **5.863**

Deaths: **68***

- › Median age: **85 years**

Hospitalisations (COVID-19 and suspected cases): **205**

- › Standard care: **170**
- › Intensive care: **35****

Hospital discharges: 552
