Current situation COVID-19: New infections, hospitalisations in intensive care, deaths

People tested **positive** for COVID-19: **3.550**

- > Residents: **2.917**
- > Non-residents: **633**
- > Average age: **46 years**
- > Ratio men / women: **50,7% / 49,3%**

Tests **carried out** since the beginning of the crisis: **33.666**

- > Residents: **27.429**
- > Non-residents: **6.237**

Deaths: **73***

- > Median age: **85 years**

Hospitalisations (COVID-19 and suspected cases): **181**

- › Standard care: **150**
- › Intensive care: **31****
