Current situation COVID-19: New infections, hospitalisations in intensive care, deaths

People tested **positive** for COVID-19: **3.558**

- › Residents: **2.921**
- › Non-residents: **637**
- › Average age: **46 years**
- › Ratio men / women: **50,7% / 49,3%**

Tests **carried out** since the beginning of the crisis: **33.798**

- › Residents: **27.532**
- › Non-residents: **6.266**

Deaths: **75 (+2)***

- › Median age: **85 years**

Hospitalisations (COVID-19 and suspected cases): **185**

- › Standard care: **153**
- › Intensive care: **32****

Hospital discharges: 637
