People tested **positive** for COVID-19: **3.618**

- › Residents: **2.951**
- › Non-residents: **667**
- › Average age: **46 years**
- › Ratio men / women: **50,9% / 49,1%**

Persons tested since the beginning of the crisis: **34.962**

- › Residents: **28.380**
- › Non-residents: **6.582**

Deaths: **78***

- › Differene to previous day: **+3**
- › Average age: **83 years**
- › Median age: **85 years**

Hospitalisations (COVID-19 and suspected cases): **185**

- › Standard care: **153**

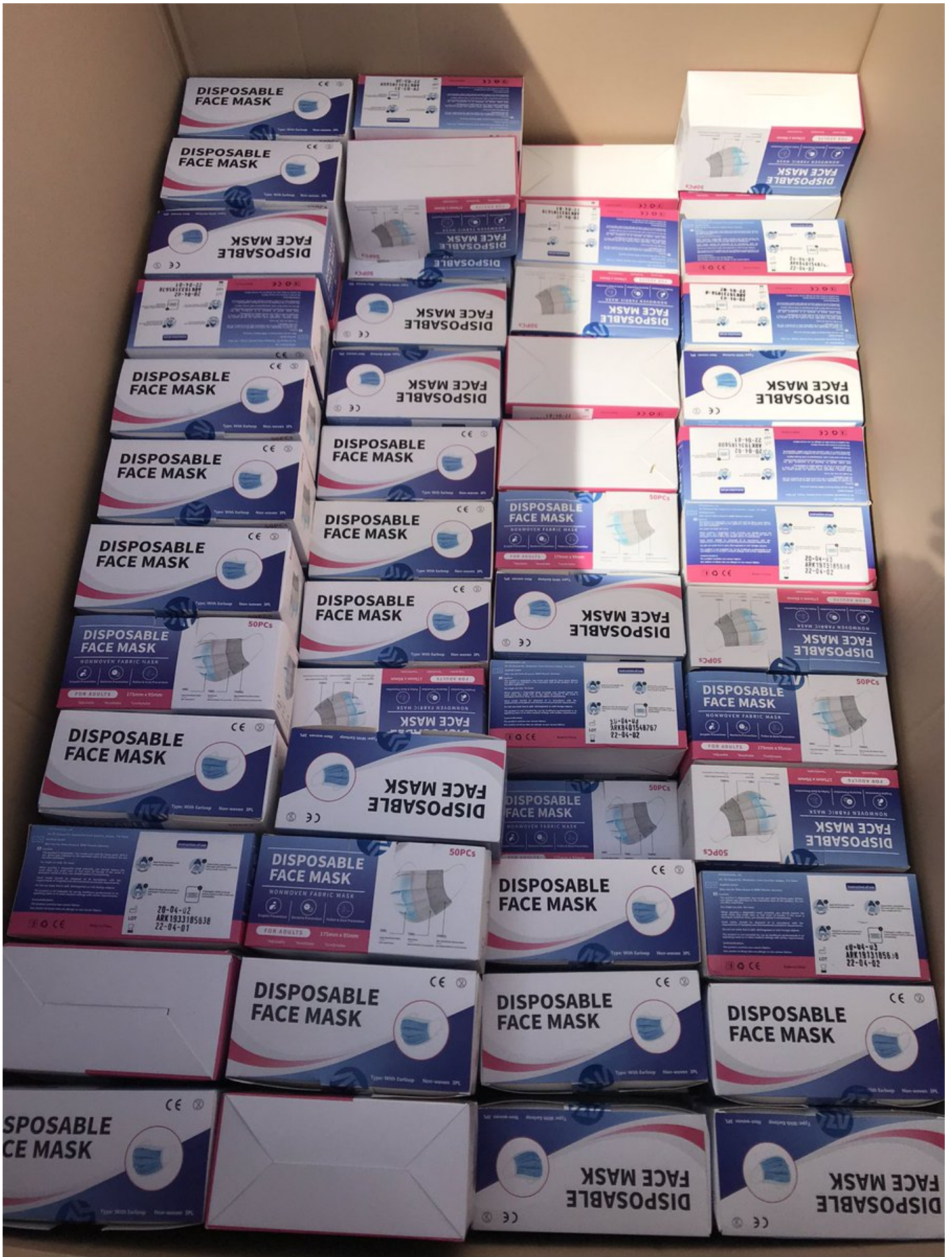
