



HIGHLIGHTS

- On the 25th of March 2020, Seven (7) new confirmed cases of COVID-19 recorded in Nigeria
- Till date, fifty-one (51) cases have been confirmed, two cases have been discharged and one death from COVID-19 recorded in Nigeria
- Of the seven (7) new cases reported on the 25th of March, three (3) are in Lagos State, one (1) is in Osun State, one (1) is in Rivers State, and one (2) is in FCT

- All new cases have mild to moderate symptoms and are currently receiving care.
- A multi-sectoral national emergency operations centre (EOC), activated at level 3, continues to coordinate the national response activities
