

## CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) HIGHLIGHTS

- On the 14th of April 2020, **30 new** confirmed cases of COVID-19 were recorded in Nigeria
- Till date, 373 cases have been confirmed, 99 cases have been discharged and eleven deaths have been recorded in Nigeria
- The **30** new cases are reported from five states- Lagos (25), FCT (2), Akwa Ibom (1), Edo (1), Kano (1).

- A multi-sectoral national emergency operations centre (EOC), activated at Level 3, continues to coordinate the national response activities
