









CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) HIGHLIGHTS

- On the 16th of April 2020, 35 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 were recorded in Nigeria
- Till date, 442 cases have been confirmed, 152 cases have been discharged and thirteen deaths have been recorded in Nigeria
- \bullet The 35 new cases are reported from four states- Lagos (19), FCT (9), Kano (5), Oyo (2).

• A multi-sectoral national emergency operations centre (EOC), activated at Level 3, continues to coordinate the national response activities
