





CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) HIGHLIGHTS

- On the 24th of April 2020, 114 new confirmed cases and one new death were recorded in Nigeria
- One new state (Zamfara) has reported a confirmed case in the last 24 hours.
- Till date, 1095 cases have been confirmed, 208 cases have been discharged and thirty two deaths have been recorded in 27 states and the Federal Capital

Territory

- The 114 new cases are reported from nine states- Lagos (80), Gombe (21), FCT (5), zamfara (2), Edo (2), Ogun (1), Oyo (1), Kaduna (1), Sokoto (1).
- A multi-sectoral national emergency operations centre (EOC), activated at Level 3, continues to coordinate the national response activities
