





CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) HIGHLIGHTS

- On the 25th of April 2020, 87 new confirmed cases and one new death were recorded in Nigeria
- One new state (Imo) has reported a confirmed case in the last 24 hours.
- Till date, 1182 cases have been confirmed, 222 cases have been discharged and thirty five deaths have been recorded in 28 states and the Federal Capital

Territory

- The 87 new cases are reported from nine states- Lagos (33), Borno (18), Osun (12), Katsina (9), Kano (4), Ekiti (4), Edo (3), Bauchi (3), Imo (1).
- A multi-sectoral national emergency operations centre (EOC), activated at Level 3, continues to coordinate the national response activities
