



Duque III commended Makati City's efforts to keep the COVID-19 infection rate low amongst its healthcare workers during his visit in the Ospital ng Makati (OsMak) and the quarantine facility in Pembo Elementary School, today. The Inter-Agency Task Force – National Task Force (IATF-NTF) and the Department of Health (DOH), with support from the Asian Development Bank (ADB), convened the TASK FORCE T3 (for Test, Trace and Treat). This public-private task force will support the Government's efforts to swiftly expand RT-PCR (Reverse Transmission – Polymerase Chain Reaction) testing for COVID-19 from the current level of approximately 4,500 per day, to at least 30,000 tests per day by May 30, 2020 ...
