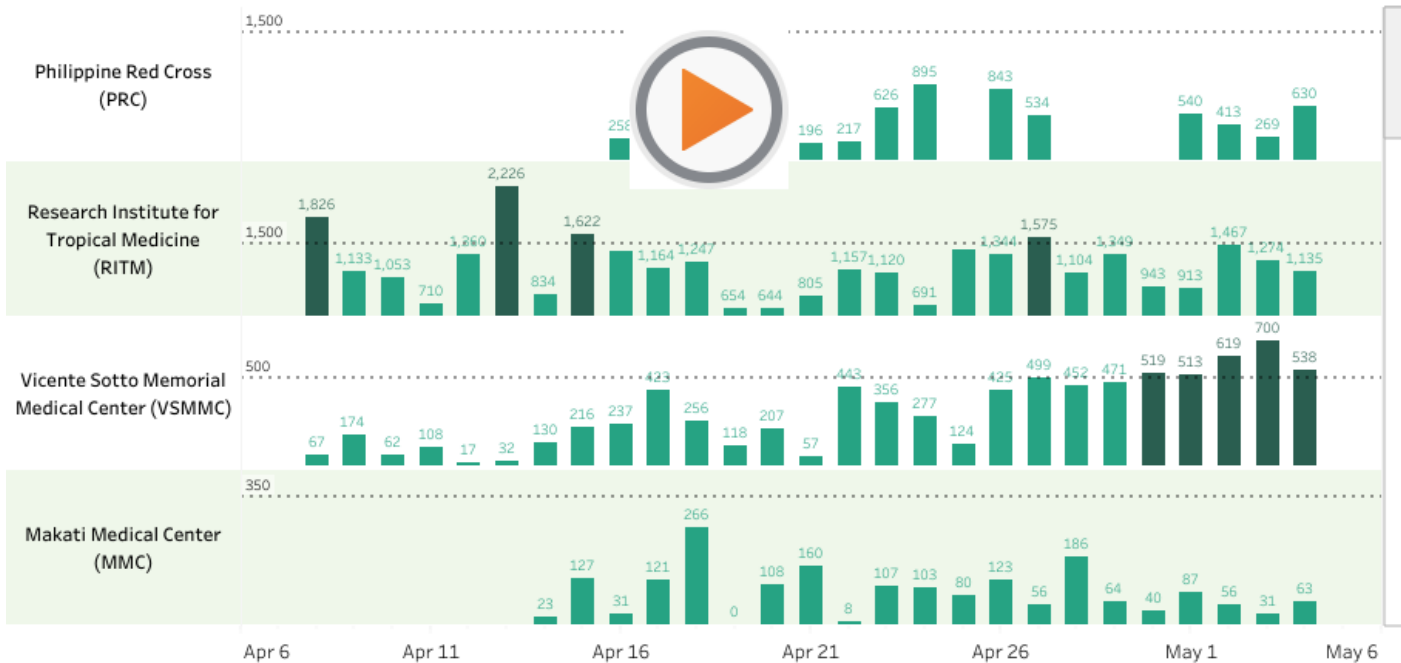

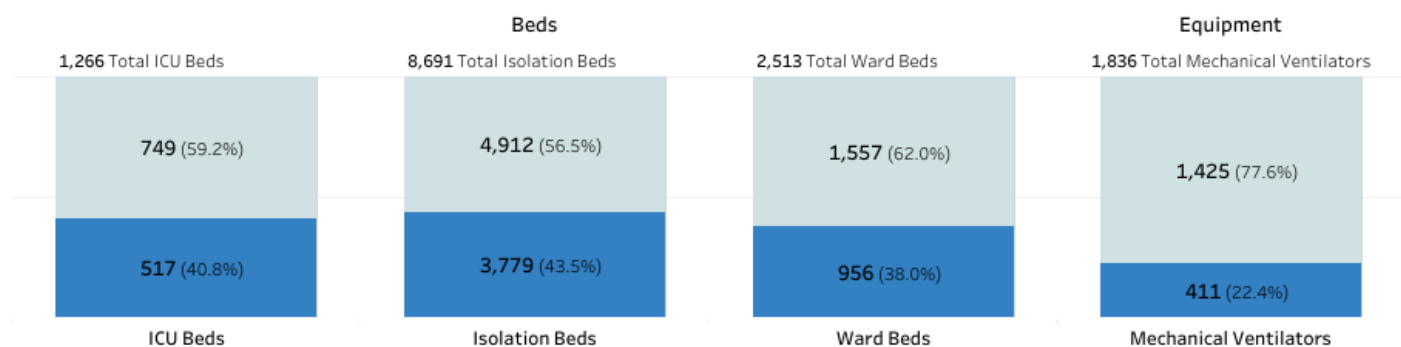

AVAILABILITY OF BEDS & MECHANICAL VENTILATORS IN DIFFERENT FACILITIES

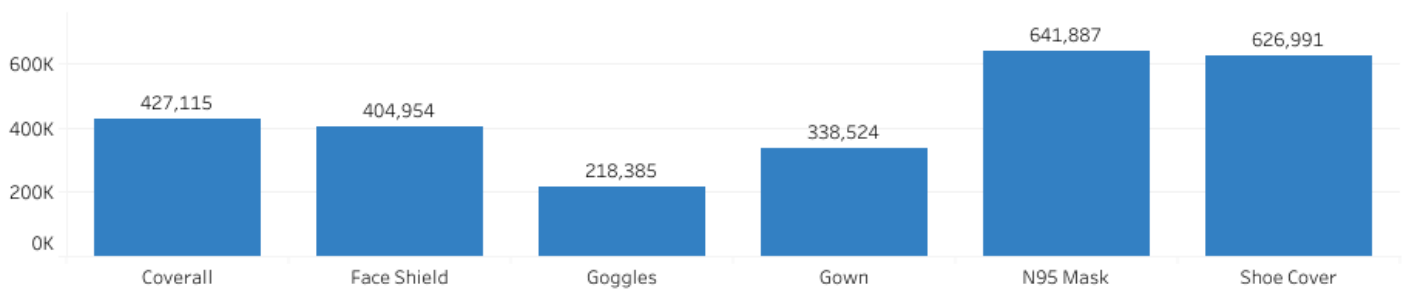

"We are still putting together the manpower who will operate these swabbing booths, but the DOH has agreed to supply these mega swabbing centers with 400 human resources for health," said Health Secretary Francisco T. Duque III signifying his commitment to support the operation of the four swabbing centers in Manila and Bulacan.</p>

In Tuesday's Beat COVID-19 Virtual Presser, the DOH also noted that the case doubling time, or the time it takes for newly reported cases to increase two-fold, has slowed significantly since the beginning of the outbreak-- one of the signs that the COVID-19 curve is starting to flatten...</p>
