- (e.g. telephones, keyboards) need to be wiped with disinfectant regularly.
- Encourage regular disinfection of commonly touched surfaces such as door handles, kettles, fridge and microwaves.
 - Disinfectant can be prepared as follows (1 portion bleach 9 portion water or as indicated on label)
 - Avoid sharing personal items & office stationeries.

Department of Health urges members of the public who have family members arriving in the country to call T41 in advance to provide the family member's following details:

- Name & surname
- Flight number and date and time of arrival
- Address in Seychelles

This will enable Public Health Officers to do necessary home visits in order to assess
