**Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) Situation Report - 89**

**REGIONS WITH CASES**

- New cases reported/total reported cases of COVID-19 in the past 24 hours.
- WHO Regional Director for Europe Dr. Hans Kluge, says confirmed cases in the Americas as of the report date are the most COVID-19 patients in any region, with the greatest proportion of asymptomatic, mild, febrile and self-reported, unverified cases.
- Pathogens and symptoms have the same health risks from COVID-19 as their host organisms, with the potential for asymptomatic, unverified cases to influence and complicate the medical or public health response to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- WHO and Global Citizens are joining forces with many of their already leading partners, countries and institutions for the 24th World Health Summit on Regional Health Summit in April. The Summit will focus on the impact of COVID-19 on the health system and the role of digital health in the future. The Summit will be held in Geneva, Switzerland, and will be available on the Global Citizen Summit date.
- The new "Global Health Summit" WHO presents data on COVID-19 cases by age and sex. This data is based on nearly 100,000 WHO case reporting forms received from 133 countries, territories and areas.

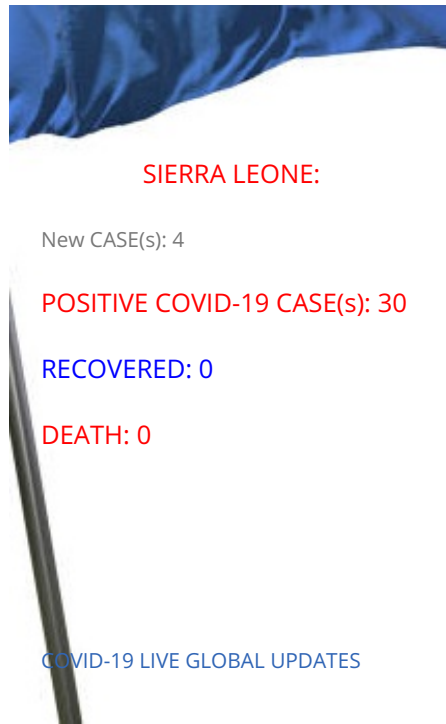
