PUBLIC NOTICE ON e-PASS POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Pursuant to the Public Notice of 24th April 2020 on the above subject, and in a bid to improve on the efficiency and transparency in the management of passes for movement of persons and vehicles during periods of restrictions, the National Emergency Operations Centre is implementing an Electronic Pass Management System (e-Pass). Electronic passes under the following policies and procedures shall apply in the issuance of e-Passes.

1. Categories Automatically eligible and not requiring a Pass

The following categories automatically qualify to move and need not apply for passes:

- Transmitters of essential goods (Food items, sanitizing water, fuel, drugs and medical supplies, construction materials)

2. Eligibility to Apply for Passes


The following categories are exempted for further restrictions upon expiry of the above categories:

- Essential service providers (Electricity, telecommunications, health services, water, gas, sewerage, information, construction, agriculture, maritime, state and police security personnel, currency exchange, post/telecom and private business operations on essential duties)
- International media and relief service providers

All requests not meeting the above criteria shall be rejected. For applications not meeting the above criteria, the Pass holder must demonstrate relative importance, or require for essential communication services as stipulated in the National Communications Act to the email address listed in Paragraph 2 below.

3. Request for Passes

All applications for passes shall be done online on the designated portal upon publication, please visit sierraleone.gov.sl and complete the online forms. For persons without internet access to a computer or mobile internet, the user
