**Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) Situation Report - 99**

**Key updates:**

- The World Health Organization (WHO) has published a document providing guidance regarding the operation of correction programs in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic. More information is available here.
- The Ministry of Health, Consumer Affairs and Social Welfare of Spain has recently changed its criteria for reporting COVID-19 cases to include only those with positive laboratory confirmation and full clinical details. This has resulted in a significant decrease in the number of reported cases in Spain.
- An update on Emergency Medical Teams, the Global Health Cluster, the Global Outbreak Alert and Response Network, the WHO Coronavirus Health and Community Engagement to promote evidence-based practices in their homes.
