(!) Clarifications On Misinformation



<u>28 Feb 2020</u>: MOH is aware of a rumour circulating on social media that a foreign domestic worker had passed away from COVID-19 in Singapore. This is not true. She was tested for COVID-19 and found to be negative.

As of 4pm on 28 Feb 2020, there has been no fatality related to COVID-19 in Singapore.

We advise members of the public to not speculate and/or spread unfounded rumours. Please visit www.moh.gov.sg for updates on the COVID-19 situation.

<u>27 Feb 2020</u>: MOH has received feedback from members of the public that they have received phone calls asking them to visit MOH's offices to collect documents. We wish to inform all members of the public that the calls are not made by MOH. We wish to clarify that we will not require anyone to collect documents from MOH's offices if they do not have any existing matter with us.

We urge everyone to verify the authenticity of phone calls claiming to be from MOH by calling our General Hotline at 6325 9220. It is a good practice to always verify the authenticity of instructions <u>before</u> offering any personal information or making payments to anyone.
