As of 9 July 2020, 12pm, the Ministry of Health (MOH) has confirmed 125 new cases of COVID-19 infection in Singapore.

Among the cases:

- Imported case: **1**
  - 1 Permanent Resident

The imported case is a Singapore Permanent Resident who returned to Singapore from India on 23 June. She had been placed on 14-day Stay-Home Notice (SHN) upon arrival in Singapore, and had been tested while serving SHN.

- Cases in the community: **21**
  - 4 Singaporeans/PRs, 3 Work Pass holders, 14 Work Permit Holders

Of the 21 cases in the community, 11 were picked up as a result of MOH's proactive surveillance and screening, and 5 had already been placed on quarantine earlier. 15 of the cases are asymptomatic, and were all detected through our proactive testing. 10 of the community cases are linked to previous cases or clusters.

- Cases residing in dormitories: **103**

Of the new cases, 91% are linked to known clusters, the rest are pending contact tracing.

322 more cases of COVID-19 infection have been discharged from hospitals or community isolation facilities. To date, 41,645 have fully recovered from the infection and have been discharged from hospitals or community isolation facilities.

Most of the 197 confirmed cases who are still in hospital are stable or improving. 1 is in critical condition in the intensive care unit.

3,554 cases who have mild symptoms, or are clinically well but still test positive for COVID-19 are isolated and cared for at community facilities.

26 have passed away from complications due to COVID-19 infection.
