Coronavirus (COVID-19): daily data for Scotland

This is updated each day to provide the latest available data on COVID-19 in Scotland.

Scottish numbers: 17 July 2020

- 17 new confirmed cases of COVID-19
- 0 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive

A total of 314,898 people in Scotland have been tested through NHS Scotland labs and UK Government Labs to date. Of these:

- 296,497 were confirmed negative
- 18,401 were positive

This will be an underestimate of the number of cases. Not everyone with the virus will display symptoms and not all those with symptoms will be tested.

Of the people who have tested positive:

- 4,140 inpatients have been discharged from hospital since 5 March
- 316 were in hospital last night: 3 of whom were in intensive care; plus 6 more people in intensive care with suspected COVID-19
- 2,491 have died
