This is updated each day to provide the latest available data on COVID-19 in Scotland.

Changes to coronavirus data page

We have been publishing data every day on this webpage since early April. Given where Scotland is now in the pandemic, and the development of new data sources we think it's a good time to refocus this publication. Further information is available in a <u>new post on the Scotlish Government statistics blog</u>.

We will also continue to review the provision of key data on COVID-19 into the future.

Scottish numbers: 24 July 2020

- 20 new confirmed cases of COVID-19; this is 0.5% of newly tested individuals (note that there were actually 22 new cases, although two previous positive cases have been de-notified and are now classified as negative; as such there is a net increase of 20 positive cases)
- 0 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 2 people were in intensive care last night with confirmed COVID-19
- 278 people were in hospital with confirmed COVID-19
- 16,338 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results
- 10 new suspected COVID-19 cases in adult care homes on 23 July

Note: this was updated at 17:15 on 24 July 2020 with 0.4% replaced by 0.5% in the first bullet

Figures by health board area

- COVID-19 positive cases and patients in hospital at both Scotland level and Health Board level are provided in published excel files <u>Trends in daily data</u>.
- Further information is provided in the <u>Public Health Scotland dashboard</u>

Weekly figures

- Positive tests: week ending 24 July: 22,621 people tested 119 positive
- Number of tests: 76,546 tests COVID-19 reported week ending 24 July.
- Care homes: as at 22 July: 81 (8%) adult care homes with a current case of suspected COVID-19
- Care homes testing: week ending 16 July: At least 1,620 individual care home staff, and 417 residents were tested in care homes with a confirmed case of COVID-19. At least 32,829 individual care home staff, and 2,019 residents were tested in care homes with no confirmed cases of COVID-19. Health Board data is available.
- Hospital admissions: week ending 15 July: On average, 1 COVID-19 patient admitted to hospital per day
- Deaths: week ending 19 July: 3 COVID-19 deaths in hospital and 3 deaths in care homes.
- Delayed discharges: As at 21 July: 872 people were delayed in hospital.
- NHS staff absence: week ending 21 July: On average, 4,007 NHS staff, or around 2.4% of the NHS workforce, reported absent each day for a range of reasons related to COVID-19.
