Coronavirus (COVID-19): daily data for Scotland

Scottish numbers: 1 October 2020

- 668 new cases of COVID-19 reported; this is 10.8% of newly tested individuals.
- 3 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 17 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19.
- 154 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19.
- 14,316 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results.

Weekly figures

- new cases reported: week ending 1 October: 38,498 people newly tested 3,952 positive.
- number of tests: 108,022 tests reported week ending 1 October (20 tests per 1,000 population).
- care homes: as at 30 September: 92 (9%) adult care homes with a current case of suspected COVID-19.
- care homes confirmed cases: 32 new positive COVID-19 cases among care home residents for week 21 -27 September.
- care homes testing: week ending 24 September: At least 1,383 individual care home staff, and 170
 residents were tested in care homes with a confirmed case of COVID-19. At least 36,568 individual care
 home staff, and 1,581 residents were tested in care homes with no confirmed cases of COVID-19. <u>Health
 Board data is available</u>.
- hospital admissions: week ending 25 September: 94 COVID-19 patients were admitted to hospital.
- deaths: week ending 27 September: 10 deaths were registered where COVID-19 was on the death certificate.
- delayed discharges: As at 30 September: 1,030 people were delayed in hospital.
- NHS staff absence: week ending 29 September: On average, 1,587 NHS staff, or around 0.9% of the NHS workforce, reported absent each day for a range of reasons related to COVID-19.
- care homes staff absence: week ending 29 September: 511 staff were reported as absent in adult care homes due to COVID-19, based on returns received from 810 (75%) adult care homes. Staff absent due to COVID-19 represents 1.2% of all adult care home staff (42,474) for whom a return was provided. The absence figures for NHS staff and care home staff are calculated in different ways and caution should be exercised in making comparisons.
- shielding: As at 3 August, 180,228 people who were identified as at high clinical risk of COVID-19 had been advised to shield up to the end of July. At that time, there had been 5,426 deaths (from all causes) of those who had been advised to shield. Shielding has been paused since the beginning of August.

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
