## Scottish numbers: 5 October 2020

### **Summary**

- 697 new cases of COVID-19 reported; this is 12.8% of newly tested individuals
- 0 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive (noting that Register Offices are now generally closed at weekends).
- 22 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 218 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 15,140 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results
