Summary

- 1,027 new cases of COVID-19 reported; this is 13.5% of newly tested individuals
- 5 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 31 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 377 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 18,796 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results
