## **Summary**

- 1,429 new cases of COVID-19 reported; this is 16.4%\* of newly tested individuals
- 15 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 49 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 570 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 22,152 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results
