Scottish numbers: 19 October 2020

Summary

- 993 new cases of COVID-19 reported; this is 17.1%* of newly tested individuals**
- 1 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive (noting that Register Offices are now generally closed at weekends)
- 61 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 754 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 16,920 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 6.4% of these were positive**
- * We have reviewed the use of this percentage, and plan to focus in future on percent of tests that are positive. Please see this article for details.
- ** These figures may be affected by weekend delays in test results being processed.
