### Summary

- 1,456 new cases of COVID-19 reported; this is 19.9%\* of newly tested individuals\*\*
- 15 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive (noting that Register Offices are now generally closed at weekends)
- 69 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 824 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 14,107 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 11.4% of these were positive\*\*
