Coronavirus (COVID-19): daily data for Scotland

This is updated each day to provide the latest available data on COVID-19 in Scotland.

Scottish numbers: 5 June 2020

- 29 new confirmed cases of COVID-19
- 14 new reported deaths of people who have tested positive

A total of 122,762 people in Scotland have been tested through NHS labs to date. Of these:

- 107.180 were confirmed negative
- 15,582 were positive

This will be an underestimate of the number of cases. Not everyone with the virus will display symptoms and not all those with symptoms will be tested.

Of the people who have tested positive:

- 3,778 inpatients have been discharged from hospital since 5 March
- 676 were in hospital last night: 16 of whom were in intensive care; plus 7 more people in intensive care with suspected COVID-19
- 2,409 have died
