Coronavirus (COVID-19): daily data for Scotland

This is updated each day to provide the latest available data on COVID-19 in Scotland.

Scottish numbers: 9 June 2020

- 14 new confirmed cases of COVID-19
- 7 new reported deaths of people who have tested positive

A total of 128, 495 people in Scotland have been tested through NHS labs to date. Of these:

- 112,842 were confirmed negative
- 15,653 were positive
- This will be an underestimate of the number of cases. Not everyone with the virus will display symptoms and not all those with symptoms will be tested.

Of the people who have tested positive:

- 3,820 inpatients have been discharged from hospital since 5th March
- 641 were in hospital last night: 15 of whom were in intensive care; plus 6 more people in intensive care with suspected COVID-19
- 2,422 have died
