Summary

- 1,739 new cases of COVID-19 reported; this is 19.8%* of newly tested individuals**
- 28 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 73 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 873 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 20,001 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 9.7% of these were positive**
- * We have reviewed the use of this percentage, and plan to focus in future on percent of tests that are positive. Please see this article for details.
- ** These figures may be affected by weekend delays in test results being processed.
