What you need to know about CORONAVIRUS (Covid-19 DISEASE)

What is Coronavirus?
This is a new virus that causes a respiratory illness in people and animals and can spread from person-to-person through sneezing and coughing droplets. This virus has signs and symptoms similar to the common cold but is dangerous and if not reported early and managed by Health Workers it can cause severe illness in humans and can lead to death.

Where did Coronavirus come from?
There are ongoing studies on the origins of Coronavirus. However, the current outbreak started in a large animal and seafood market in China, in a city called Wuhan.

How does Coronavirus spread?
Initially, the virus was believed to be spread to humans through contact with infected animals. Currently, transmission is human-to-human. It occurs when an infected person's sneeze or cough droplets come into contact with another person.

COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS) (Covid-19 DISEASE)

The World Health Organization declared Coronavirus (COVID-19) a pandemic in March to rapidly spreading across the globe. Uganda is one of the African countries that have implemented control and prevention measures to stop the spread of Coronavirus. The Ministry of Health has issued the following guidelines to all responsible officers to ensure that the spread of Coronavirus is contained.

1. Health Ministry, Department, Agency and Local Government should immediately challenge and if necessary, assist to ensure that suspected cases are reported to the Health Workers and the Security Organs as required by these guidelines.
2. All those staff providing Health Services and the Security Organs are expected to follow these guidelines.
3. Suspected cases should be managed in accordance with the guidelines and the Ministry of Health should be notified immediately.

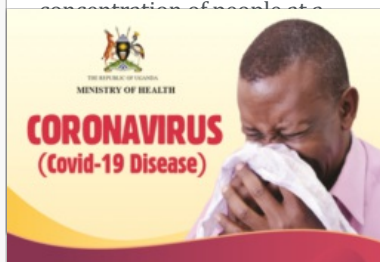

There is ample evidence that mass gatherings can increase the risk of transmission of infectious diseases such as Coronavirus (COVID-19). The Ministry of Health is providing this guideline for consideration by organizers of mass gatherings in the context of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. Examples of Mass Gatherings include:

- Sporting events eg football matches, betting
- Religious events eg Prayer congregations, crusades, pilgrimages etc
- Social/Cultural events eg funerals, weddings
- Political events eg rallies, campaigns, national events

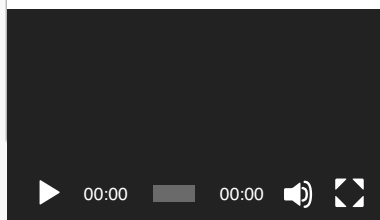

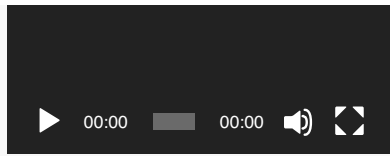
