

THE COVID-19 OUTBREAK IN UGANDA

20th April, 2020: The Ministry of Health confirms two CDVID-19 gealitive eases one (I) case from 291 samples steeld from truck drivers at boarder points of antiard one (I) from 288 samples taken from the community and quarantine centres. A total of 1,127 samples were tested today at the Uganda Virus Research institution (UVRI). The total number of confirmed CDVID-19 cases now to 35 (This include the 2 Semmes truck distances.

The international Health Regulations (IHR) requires that every case that is tested and confirmed for a perticular disease should be registered as the host country's case. It is therefore against this background that Uganda will capture all COVID-19 positive foreigners including truck drivers as part of her confirmed cases and

To-date, 5 truck drivers (1 Ugandan, 1 Tanzanian and 3 Kerryens) have tested positive for COVID-19. Out of these, 2 truck drivers (1 Tanzanian and 1 Kerryan)


