UPDATE ON THE COVID-19 OUTBREAK IN UGANDA

20" April, 2020- The Ministry of Health confirms two COVID-19 positive eases one (1) case from 929 samples tested from truck drivers as borned points of any and one (1) from 246 samples taken from the community and quarantine centres. A total of 1,172 samples were tested today at the Uganda Virus Research institut (UVIII). The total number of confirmed COVID-19 cases now is 58 (This include the 2 Kernyan track drivers who are currently believe treated in Usanda).

The international Health Regulations (IHR) requires that every case that is tested and confirmed for a persicular disease should be registered as the host country's case. It is therefore against this background that Uganda will capture all COVID-19 positive foreigness including truck drivers as part of her confirmed cases and treated in Uganda.

To-date, 5 truck drivers (1 Ugandan, 1 Tanzanian and 3 Kerryans) have tested positive for COVID-19. Out of these, 2 truck drivers (1 Tanzanian and 1 Kersyanian and 1 Kersyanian
