

The international Health Regulations (IHR) requires that every case that it tested and confirmed for a perticular disease should be registered as the host country's case. It is therefore against this background that Uganda will capture all COVID-19 positive foreigners including truck drivers as part of her confirmed cases and treated in Uganda.

To-date, 5 truck drivers (1 Ugandan, 1 Tanzanian and 3 Kerryens) have texted positive for COVID-19. Out of these, 2 truck drivers (1 Tanzanian and 1 Kerryan)
