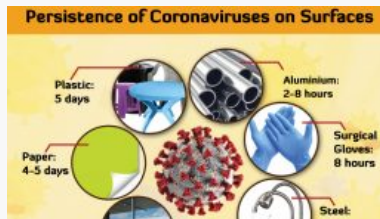

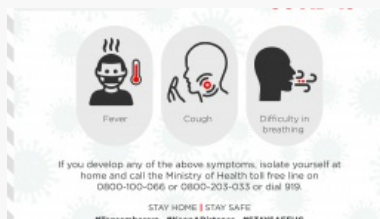

Guidelines for the use of Masks

1. What are the types of masks on the Ugandan market?	<p>There are two types of masks on the Ugandan market namely:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">A. MedicalB. Non-medical <ul style="list-style-type: none">The medical masks include: N95, KN95 and surgical masks.The non-medical masks are made out of fabric, cloth or paper. Medical masks should be reserved for health workers in health facilities and not for the general public since it is used in a hospital environment. It is highly contaminated by various infectious organisms and is more costly.
2. How do these masks work?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">COVID-19 is spread through sneezing, coughing, talking and breathing.When an infected person wears a face mask, the mask catches the virus from sneezing through breathing, coughing, talking and breathing.The mask also prevents droplets from an infected person reaching the nose and mouth of the person ahead of it.
3. What type of masks should be used by the community?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The community is encouraged to use non-medical masks (made from cloth or fabric) and surgical masks.A 4-layer cotton mask with a filter material (e.g. paper, tissue or coffee filter) or polypropylene filter material offers good for non-public, everyday usage. These materials work as a filter and can be removed before washing. They are reusable, washable and durable.
4. How do these masks and other face masks?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">What is a double cloth mask (used only a face mask, it is not a double cloth mask).All masks.Children aged 6 years and above should wear face masks with breathing difficulties. You can seek advice from medical personnel.Children aged 6-12 years are very active and cannot take care of their masks and maintain hygiene. They should only use non-medical masks under supervision.Children under 6 years should not wear a mask as they have a small lung capacity.

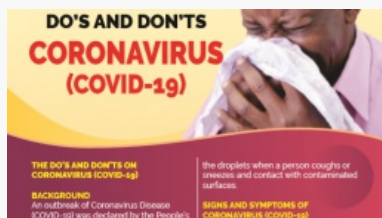
