Scottish numbers: 12 October 2020

Summary

- 961 new cases of COVID-19 reported; this is 17.1%* of newly tested individuals
- 0 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive (noting that Register Offices are now generally closed at weekends)
- 36 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 487 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 12,994 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results
