Scottish numbers: 22 October 2020

Summary

- 1,712 new cases of COVID-19 reported; this is 19.8%* of newly tested individuals
- 17 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 74 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 928 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 20,689 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results - 9.2% of these were positive
