## **Summary**

- 1,401 new cases of COVID-19 reported; this is 20.6%\* of newly tested individuals
- 18 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 76 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 975 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 19,014 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 8.0% of these were positive
