## **Summary**

- 1,433 new cases of COVID-19 reported; this is 19.1%\* of newly tested individuals\*\*
- 11 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 84 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 985 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 18,293 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 8.7% of these were positive\*\*
