Summary

- 934* new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 3 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive (noting that Register Offices are now generally closed at weekends)
- 58 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,061 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 20,923* new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 5.1% of these were positive

*Testing figures may have been affected due to issues with data transfer from NHS Grampian and NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde labs over the weekend. Additionally, it appears that the increased number of new cases today (when compared with 572 reported yesterday) may be due to a catch up of a backlog of data.
