Scottish numbers: 21 December 2020

Summary

- 1,504* new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 0 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive (noting that Register Offices are now generally closed at weekends)
- 59 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,078 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 28,051 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 6.0% of these were positive

Local area data

- Public Health Scotland's <u>interactive dashboard</u> now provides a map showing the number of cases in local areas, as well as trends for local authorities and NHS boards
- * The increased number of new cases today (when compared with 934 reported yesterday) may have been affected by backlog issues at UK Government laboratories over the weekend.
