- 1,316* new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 43 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 60 people were in intensive care yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,045 people were in hospital yesterday with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 19,547 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 7.5% of these were positive

* The increased number of new cases in the past few days may have been affected by backlog issues at UK Government laboratories over the weekend. The backlog has reduced but is also likely to have affected today's figures.
