Summary

- 1,190 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 26,530 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 5.0% of these were positive
- 47 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 56 people were in intensive care on 22 December with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,025 people were in hospital on 22 December with recently confirmed COVID-19

During the festive period, daily updates will be published to provide the latest data on the number of new cases of COVID-19 and the positivity rate. Over the holiday weekends of 25-28 December and 1-4 January there will be no updates to the remaining statistics. These will be updated on Tuesday 29 December and Tuesday 5 January – we will provide the latest daily data for that day and the previous 4 days.
