# Scottish numbers: 24 December 2020

## Summary

- 1,314 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 27,872 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results – 5.3% of these were positive
- On 24th December, 43 new reported deaths of people who have tested positive
- 56 people were in intensive care on 23rd December with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,008 people were in hospital on 23rd December with recently confirmed COVID-19

During the festive period, daily updates will be published to provide the latest data on the number of new cases of COVID-19 and the test positivity rate. Over the holiday weekends of 25-28 December and 1-4 January there will be no updates to the remaining statistics – you can access the latest available data in the sections below. These will be updated on Tuesday 29 December and Tuesday 5 January – we will provide the latest daily data for that day and the previous 4 days.
