Summary

- 2,137 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 21,451 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 10.8% of these were positive

During 1 to 4 January, daily updates will be published to provide the latest data on the number of new cases of COVID-19 and the test positivity rate.
