Scottish numbers: 17 January 2021

Summary

- 1,341 new cases of COVID-19 reported
- 16,256 new tests for COVID-19 that reported results 9.5% of these were positive
- 0 new reported death(s) of people who have tested positive
- 147 people are in intensive care with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 1,918 people are in hospital with recently confirmed COVID-19
- 224,840 people have received their first dose of the COVID-19 vaccination and 3,331 have received their second dose
